

MEMBERSHIP : MAJOR THEATRE COMPANIES*

Stages (The Western Australian Playwrights' Consortium Inc) commenced activities in 1991 and provides a program of support for the development of WA playwrights and plays. Members receive discounts on assessment fees and other services and notice of relevant activities. Members also vote for the Board of Directors at the Annual General Meeting (see below).

There are three general categories of membership: established writers; other individuals and organisations; major subsidised theatre companies. (There is also a specific membership category available to one representative from the Australian Writers' Guild). Stages is managed by a Board of Directors comprising members from the various categories. Elected Directors of the Board of Stages must be financial members at the time of election. The membership fee is determined each year at the Annual General Meeting and is currently \$27.50 (inc. GST) for all categories of membership. Membership renewals must be paid within one month prior to the AGM.

*There is a separate application form for established writers and other individuals and organisations.

“Major subsidised theatre companies” are regarded as theatre or other performance companies in receipt of annual Government funding by State and/or Commonwealth agencies. Up to three members from this category can be elected to the Board of Directors of Stages. Other members from this category can be co-opted.
